As always, the Foundation was pleased to help these talented young people as they go on to compete and represent the valley area.

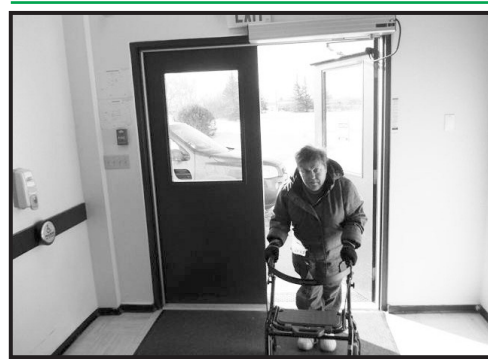
Valley Girl on her Way to Becoming a Veterinarian

Thanks in part to a scholarship established through The Community Foundation of Swan Valley by the late Dr. Rex Leach and his wife Beverly, Candace Wenzel is now in her third year of studies at the Western College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Saskatchewan. When she was only five years old Candace remembers watching Dr. Leach perform a caesarian section at his old clinic and says it left her with lasting impression about what she wanted to do with her life. This past summer she worked at the local vet clinic where she received a lot of hands-on experience that she would never have had any where else. Veterinarian medicine is a combination of both science and art which Candace says is "a constant and a continuous learning experience". Candace Wenzel is only one of many young valley students to benefit from scholarships and bursaries made possible through the Community Foundation of Swan Valley.



**Board Members Admire New Laptop**

With financial assistance from the Community Foundation of Swan Valley, Service to Seniors staff now have a new laptop that will be used in a variety of ways vital to their work. In conjunction with the projector the Foundation helped fund in 2013, presentations for educational programs on aging can now be viewed at staff meetings, seminars, out in the community, and by the volunteer board members. Service to Seniors plays an important role in this rural community by offering a number of things such as the Lifeline Program, nutritious congregate meals, assistance with referrals to other agencies, transportation to medical appointments for a nominal fee, foot care in the home, blood pressure clinics, finding reliable people to help with odd jobs for a reasonable price, as well as social activities, entertainment, and a library outreach program. With today's aging community, the Foundation is pleased to be a part of this much-needed program.

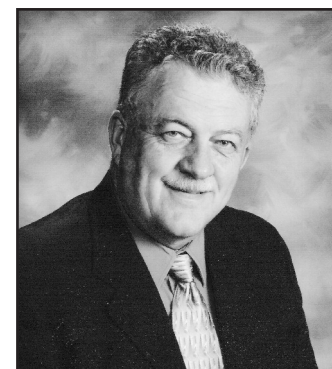


**New Automated Doors for ACL Resource Centre**

It is also used for meetings by the Special Olympics and the Crisis Centre, as well as training programs, entertainment, and other activities. The new doors put an end to long-standing safety and health concerns and ensure that the building is fully accessible by participants who have mobility issues. **Swan Valley Communities That Care**

Approximately three years ago, the Swan Valley was one of three pilot communities selected to take part in the "Communities That Care Program" which provides support from mobilization to evaluation and community planning. Under the direction of a co-ordinator and a volunteer board of directors, they have partnered with a number of local groups and organizations, including the RCMP and school officials, to address concerns such as alcohol and drug abuse, delinquency, teen pregnancy, school drop-outs, depression, and suicide. Their aim is to reward positive behaviour and to ensure young people that they are valued and have a voice. To ensure a visible presence in the area, they have initiated fun activities such as the Halloween Spooktober-Fest, and in December the very successful Swan Valley Toys 4 U drive. To date, feedback on their initiatives has been very positive and the Community Foundation of Swan Valley is pleased to be a part of their efforts to make this valley a better place to live, to work, and to raise a family.

FOUNDATION SUPPORTS HEALTH PROGRAM

In today's hectic, fast-paced, stressful world, some residents may need assistance to see them through the rough times. To address this need for support groups, the Community Foundation has provided a grant to The Health Awareness Program that promotes a healthier lifestyle, and the tools with which to achieve it. It's designed to deal with three separate issues: depression recovery, smoking cessation, and weight loss. Each initiative will be conducted by a group of well trained volunteers, with monthly follow-up sessions. The grant money will be used towards training and advertising expenses, plus the purchase of text books and other related materials. Although made possible through the Health Awareness Department of the Swan River Seventh-day Adventist Church, it is essentially a non-religious support program open to all residents. The Foundation is pleased to help make these programs available to residents of the valley.
