In just over 14 years, approximately \$460,000 in grants have helped a variety of organizations, clubs and community groups. This does not include the bursaries and scholarships that have helped our young people further their education.

Parkland Special Olympics

Stylish new travelling uniforms were provided to athletes who comprise the 35-members who make up the Parkland Special Olympics team. Wearing their new uniforms with pride, the program has a positive impact on the lives and health of these athletes who regularly participate in-inter-regional provincial events. It allows them to socialize with other participants and helps empower all aspects of their lives. The athletes worked hard to raise funds for the uniforms and the Community Foundation is pleased to have helped with a grant to cover the rest of the cost.

Sunflower Early Learning Centre

Budding young chefs can practise their talents in this well-equipped kitchen at the Sunflower Early Learning Centre in Minitonas. Without government funding, the centre has relied on the generosity of supporters to help obtain toys and equipment. With three grants, The Community Foundation of Swan Valley helped purchase a two-way intercom system to monitor who to allow into the school during non-school hours, provide funds for play equipment, carpeting, and much-needed shelving. The only day-care centre in Minitonas, Sunflower has now met all licencing requirements, they are very grateful to the Foundation for their initial support.

Bowsman Garden Club

A financial donation from the Community Foundation has assisted the Bowsman Garden Club with maintaining, improving, and expanding their program. They now have a new garden shed in which to store their tools at the end of the season. With the expansion of their garden boxes, they hope to double or triple their produce at the end of the growing season. The enthusiastic students ask residents to check out the garden area and to help themselves to a taste of their gardening talents. Without support from the local foundation, the principal stressed that their worthwhile project would not have been possible.

REPORT FROM THE BOARD

Philanthropy has been defined as 'the desire to promote the welfare of others, expressed especially by the donation of money to good causes'. Philanthropy has also been described as generosity, social conscience, brotherly love, kindness and compassion. Since our beginnings in 2005, the people of and those with connection to the Swan River Valley have demonstrated that philanthropy is indeed alive and well in our community. Thanks to you, your Community Foundation has once again enjoyed a very successful year.

The CFSV has experienced significant growth. During the past fiscal year, the Foundation has received in excess of \$162,000 in new contributions and has now reached \$1.875 million in contributions since 2005. And over the past year, the market value of the Foundation has increased by almost \$222,000 and at year's end stood at over\$2.42 million. The Foundation has enjoyed a 10.94% average rate of return on its investments over the past 5 years. The best news of all is that the Community Foundation was able to distribute \$86,282 in grants and scholarships during the year, bringing our total giving since 2005 to \$483,681.

One significant change that the CFSV made this past year was the creation of a second granting period in the spring of the year. Grant applications are now accepted in the spring and in the fall. This change should make it easier for successful applicants to receive their funding in a more timely manner. Thank you to everyone that has contributed to the CFSV, whether with financial contributions or with your volunteer time and energy. The work of the

CFSV is something we can all be excited about.
